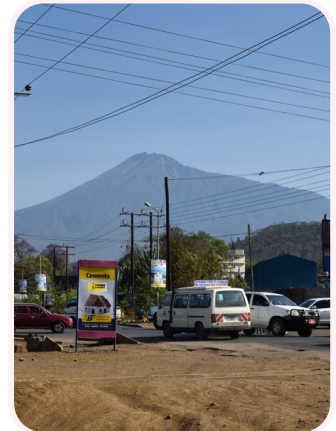
Day 1: Thursday March 4th

Accommodation: Outpost Lodge (outpost-lodge.com/)

Welcome to Tanzania!

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your accommodation in Arusha (approx. 1-hour drive).

You will settle in and enjoy dinner at the hotel at your leisure



Day 2: Friday March 5th

Accommodation: Outpost Lodge (outpost-lodge.com/)

9am Carley will meet you for a general orientation:

- Trip overview & answer questions
- The Ujamaa story
- Organise cash

11am - drive 20mins to the Tengeru Village Development Centre – a free early childhood program for 80 children aged 2-6yrs where they receive education and 2 meals a day, 5 days a week. You will stay at the centre for about an hour and then **drive 15mins to lunch in the beautiful gardens at Rivertrees** (cost not included)

4pm head to Ujamaa Children's Home to meet the children, spend some time doing activities and enjoy a traditional Tanzanian dinner at the home.

After dinner you will return to the hotel.

Day 3: Saturday March 6th

Accommodation: Outpost Lodge (outpost-lodge.com/)

9am pickup to visit the Arusha Declaration Museum to learn about the history of Tanzania and its Independence, followed by a **tour around the main food market** to see where we buy all the things to supply our home.

Lunch at Ujamaa Children's Home for a traditional Tanzanian meal, then **depart at 1.30pm with all the kids for a cultural afternoon at the Arusha Cultural Arts Centre**, where you will enjoy a drumming/dance workshop and a traditional dance performance.

Dinner at Amber Restaurant (cost not included).

Day 4: Sunday March 7th

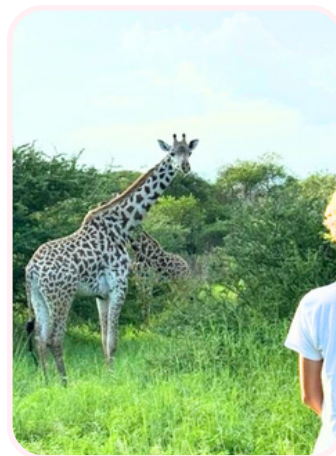
Accommodation: Outpost Lodge (outpost-lodge.com/)

9am pick up to drive for an hour to the **Arusha Giraffe Centre** where you will enjoy a **'Walk with the Giraffe'** and some morning tea while learning the incredible conservation and regeneration work they are doing to support Giraffes in their natural habitat.

1pm lunch at the beautiful Schwari & Blue Heron Restaurant with a fabulous view of Mt Meru (cost not included).

After lunch you will go back into town to wander through the stalls at the **Maasai Craft Market** to look at souvenirs and local artwork (remember looking is free!) then make your way back to the hotel to **prepare for safari and enjoy dinner at your leisure.**

Day 5: Monday March 8th

Accommodation: Manyara's Secret (www.manyarassecret.com/)

SAFARI TIME!

7.30am pickup and drive for 2.5hrs to the entrance to Tarangire National Park, one of Tanzania's largest parks. Tarangire is a sanctuary for an unusually large elephant population with up to six thousand elephants! Majestic baobab trees are a feature of the park and there is a great diversity of wildlife including giraffe, zebra, lion, leopard and cheetah. You will game drive for a few hours and then stop at **Tarangire Safari Lodge for a beautiful lunch with spectacular views.**

After lunch you will spend the afternoon game driving until you **leave the park around 3pm and drive 1hr to your accommodation** on the edge of Lake Manyara. You will experience a local maasai boma tour, then watch the sunset over the lake and enjoy a drink!

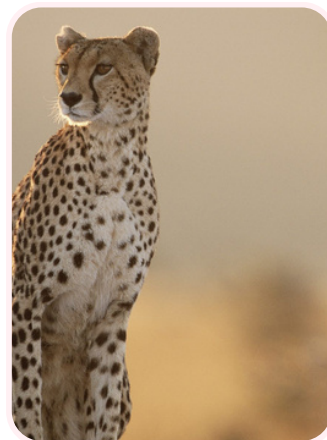


Day 6: Tuesday March 9th

Accommodation: Baobab Camp Serengeti (baobablodges.com/central-serengeti-camp/)

8am departure for a long day of driving - all the way to Central Serengeti! You will drive for about 2hrs to get to the Ngorongoro Crater Gate, then continue past the crater rim and on for 5-6hrs into the Serengeti National Park, game driving along the way! **You will enjoy your lunchbox along the way.** The Serengeti is home to over a million wildebeest and zebra, and in huge flat plains you are likely to find lion, cheetah, leopard, hyena and many other small predators, as well as giraffe, warthogs and an incredible number of impala, gazelle, topi, waterbuck, heart beast and many more! Bird spotting is also a highlight. After a fantastic day of animal encounters, you will **enjoy the incredible experience of sleeping in a tented camp in the middle of the Serengeti, listening to the wildlife.**

Day 7: Wednesday March 10th

Accommodation: Baobab Camp Serengeti
(baobablodges.com/central-serengeti-camp/)

Today you have a full day to explore the Serengeti! You have the **option of a dawn balloon ride (additional cost US\$599)** as well as 2 game drives, with a break in the middle to return to camp for lunch. You can choose to go on all drives or spend some time relaxing at the camp in the stunning wilderness.

Day 8: Thursday March 11th

Accommodation: Serena Ngorongoro Lodge
(www.serenahotels.com/ngorongoro)

After an early breakfast you get on the road at **7.30am to enjoy a game drive through the Serengeti as you head towards the Ngorongoro Crater.** Today is another big day of driving. You will stop to eat your lunchbox at Olduvai Gorge – known as the ‘Cradle of Mankind’ where you can visit the museum and learn about ancient man.

Around 5pm you will finish the drive at your Ngorongoro Crater accommodation to relax and enjoy the view.

All meals included (drinks & tips paid directly to lodge).



Day 9: Friday March 12th

Accommodation: Outpost Lodge (outpost-lodge.com/)

6.30am you will descend into the Ngorongoro Crater – a haven for wildlife. It is unique in that almost all the wildlife lives within the crater walls so you can find game easily. Rhino can often be seen as well as prides of lion and many other animals. **Around midday** you will head out of the crater to your **incredible lunch experience at Gibbs Farm** (approx. 1hr) (www.gibbsfarm.com). After a leisurely lunch, you make your way back to Arusha (approx. 2.5hrs), return to your hotel to relax after your big adventure.

Enjoy dinner at your hotel at your leisure. (cost not included)

Day 10: Saturday March 13th

Accommodation: Outpost Lodge (outpost-lodge.com/)

A quiet time to relax after safari.

10.30am pick up to drive 20mins to Dunia to enjoy a "Waste to Wonder" tour of this plastic recycling company. Then **10mins on to Shanga**, a glass and bead company that provides employment to people with disabilities. You'll have a workshop tour to learn about the process of making the products. A delicious **lunch at The Arusha Coffee Lodge** next door in the beautiful gardens...watch out the monkeys don't steal your food! (cost not included) After lunch, on to the **Cultural Heritage Centre** where you can explore the largest Gallery of African Art on the continent. There are also a range of gift shops to explore (though more expensive than the markets). After a little rest at the hotel you will enjoy **dinner at George's Tavern**.

Accommodation: Outpost Lodge (outpost-lodge.com/)

This morning you can choose whether you would like to attend church with the kids, relax at your hotel or do some last-minute shopping at the Masai craft market.

Enjoy lunch at Ujamaa Children's Home and then join the kids for a **Tinga Tinga Art workshop** before your final farewell.

There will be lots of sad goodbyes when you leave!

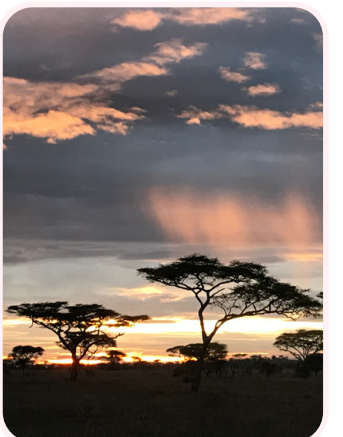
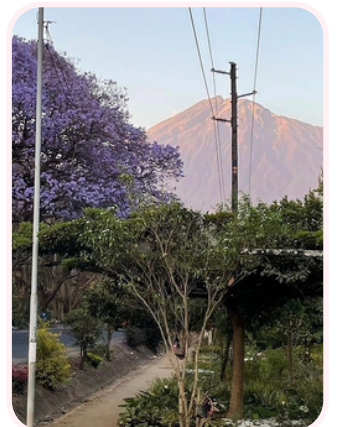

Confirmation Policy:

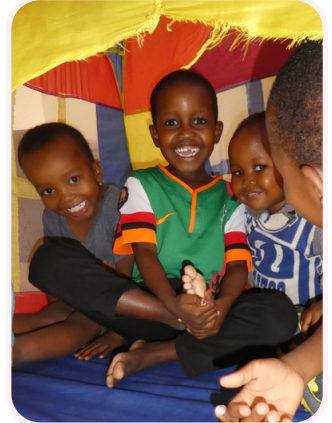
- A deposit of US\$500 per person is required to secure your booking
- All payments will be exchanged from personal currency, (such as Australian Dollars) on the day of transfer to reflect relevant rate
- Final payment due by January 4th 2027

Cancellation Policy:

General cancellation fees are as follows

- Before final payment - full refund minus bank fees and exchange rate transfer difference
- After final payment - US\$500 deposit is non-refundable. Balance of payment will be refunded as much as possible, dependant on individual accommodation cancellation policies and costs already incurred
- No refunds available after tour has commenced
